In order to transport the skiers most efficiently and pleasantly to the slopes, three new Mercedes buses with the newest ICT technology have been purchased. These buses are each equipped with two monitors and a standard vehicle computer running FourC's IoT-based Cities in Motion Open Service Platform. The current selection of services include LiveScreen, an infotainment solution by Dogu AS; Passenger Wi-Fi; Beaconizer, a service that

offers beacons without batteries; and soon **Passenger Flow Analysis**, the revolutionary service that measures travel statistics without costly installations.

"It quite fun to realize that our three buses have the most modern ICT solution in the whole of Norway!", says COO for SkiGeilo, Ole K. Kristiansen. "We think that our customers will appreciate the effort we have put into making their visit to Geilo as pleasurable and rewarding as possible in all aspects of their stay."
